#### **CONSTITUENCY ACTIVITY**

These are the issues that I have worked on over the past year many of which are ongoing: -

## A467 Dual Carriageway

Residents in the Dan Y Graig area have concerns about road noise from the A467. These concerns have been raised on multiple occasions with the Council, including a site visit with the relevant officer and Cabinet Member, and this is an ongoing matter. A number of concerns were also raised about grass overgrowth at the sides of the road and at the roundabout. I raised these concerns with the relevant officers.

## **Tesco Section 106 Money**

I have attended meetings and had discussions with officers to discuss the use of Section 106 money related to the construction of Tesco. These discussions were reflected in a report which was presented to Cabinet.

## **Church Road**

There is an ongoing issue on Church Road with drivers using horns at the bottom of the road and large vehicles getting stuck using it. I raised these matters with the relevant officers and options are being considered in relation to this. Residents will be consulted on these options before any changes are made.

#### **Potholes**

A number of potholes were reported after the winter, and I have been reporting these as and when they appear. To date most of these have now been repaired. I raised the particular matter of Mill Street with the relevant officers. This is ongoing.

## Fly Tipping / Litter

I received a number of reports of fly tipping around the ward, especially in Ocherwyth. Individual cases were reported and cleared, but this is an ongoing matter which continues to be a problem. I frequently report litter and overflowing bins, including dog waste bins, and these are regularly dealt with. This is an ongoing matter which frequently resurfaces.

#### **Virgin Media Works**

Since the Virgin Media works to install new internet cabling has started, I became aware of a number of issues relating to the works. I raised these matters with Virgin Media but this will continue as an on-going matter until the works in the ward are completed.

# Illegal / Inconsiderate Parking

There have been regular reports of inconsiderate and illegal parking throughout the ward including on Tredegar Street, Park Road, Isaf Road, and others. I have reported these matters and joined the local Police Community Support Officer on an awareness raising exercise.

#### **Housing Queries**

I have received a number of queries relating to housing. I have assisted residents by providing information relating to their individual cases, as well as raising matters with the relevant officers, and this continues to be an ongoing matter.

#### **Anti-Social Behaviour**

I have been made aware of reports of anti-social behaviour in specific areas of the ward. These have been raised with the relevant authorities but continue as ongoing matters.

#### **Social Media**

I have been using social media to communicate with residents about important ongoing matters. These include school closures as a result of snow earlier in the year, and other matters of local interest. My Facebook page 'Cllr Ross Whiting – Risca West' is currently 'liked' by 473 people, and I regularly receive queries and message via the page..

# **Risca Town Council**

Although I am not a member of Risca Town Council, I have attended most meetings this year to provide them with county members' updates. I have reported issues raised by Town Councillors, and attended most of their community events.
