CIVIC DUTIES

I was very proud to be elected as Mayor of Caerphilly County Borough Council in September 2020. Unfortunately, due to restrictions, I have only been unable to carry out 2 face to face engagements and attend 2 virtual events since September. I am pleased to report that 10 bouquets of flowers and cards have been delivered on my behalf to residents celebrating special anniversaries and 100th birthdays during the year.

DEMENTIA FRIEND CHAMPION

I am the Dementia Friend Champion for the Authority and continue to raise awareness of dementia in Caerphilly in memory of my father in law, the late Councillor Harry Andrews MBE.

As part of this role I work closely with Phil Diamond, Theme Lead for Gwent Health and Social Care Transformation Team and Natasha Harris, Policy and Project Officer for Gwent Regional Partnership Team and Chair the Caerphilly Dementia Friendly Community Meetings. Organisations and Schools continue to join Caerphilly's Dementia Friendly Community. During the pandemic I have been working with the Getting There Together Gwent Project, which is part of a national project looking to bring together a resource for people living with dementia and their carers to begin to support social and functional activity recovery as COVID-19 restrictions are eased. I also attend meetings of the Bargoed Integrated Wellbeing Network organised by Dr David Llewellyn of Aneurin Bevan University Health Board. An aim of this network is to gain accreditation for Bargoed to become a Dementia Friendly Community. I also chair this Task and Finish group.

WARD ACTIVITY

Over the past year I have continued carrying out my role as a Councillor, representing my community and providing assistance during a difficult time. I have assisted residents during the COVID-19 pandemic as much as I can whilst working as a staff nurse in Ysbyty Ystrad Fawr.

I do not hold surgeries as I am happy to be contacted at home, by phone, email or by my dedicated councillor social media accounts.

Issues I have dealt with this year have included fly tipping on Bargoed Common, litter, housing, residential parking and removal of parking restrictions, liaising with Hefin David MS regarding concerns over COVID-19 vaccinations, Quad bike use in inappropriate areas, ungritted paths around sheltered housing and street lighting concerns. Meetings with Gwent Police are temporarily suspended but I remain in contact with them via email.
