## **CONSTITUENCY ACTIVITY**

### Groesfaen Terrace

I worked with the residents association and our Highways Department and Country Parks Department in order to improve the area around The terrace, resulting in the car park at The Terrace being resurfaced.

### Deri

I worked with our Highways department in the resurfacing of the highways at Darran houses and to set out additional resurfacing areas for attention

I worked with our Education Department/School and Country Park in the setting up of "A Safe Routes To School" along the old disused railway line/

### Pentwyn

I worked with Groundwork Trust in order to initially stop sheep trespassing onto the Pentwyn Cemetery whilst a more permanent rebuilt stonewall is to be carried out. This is being processed.

### Fochriw

I worked with our Animal Trespass Officer and the Commoners Association in the repair of fencing around the village in order to prevent sheep access (unfortunately this is an ongoing process due to the fact that fences are continually being cut in order to gain access to the common).

I attended Fochriw Residents Association meetings where many issues are discussed regarding the Village

I assisted Fochriw Allotment Society regarding various issues on the allotments

I worked with Fochriw Football Club in the installation of new referees changing rooms and upgrade of old pavilion

I assisted the Fochriw Carnival Committee with the paperwork involved in setting up this years Carnival.

I was contacted by residents regarding many issues including housing requests and regularly visit their homes in order to discuss and advise them.
