CONSTITUENCY ACTIVITY

I don't hold surgeries as I post my address and telephone number to my constituents twice a year so they can get in touch with me at anytime.

Together with my ward colleague we secured funding from the Gelligaer Community Council for the erection of a bus shelter outside the Cross Keys public house and road safety improvements on the A469 under Hengoed Viaduct.

I have dealt with a number of constituents seeking advice about housing applications and repairs and social service issues and taken up these cases with the appropriate officers.

Also I have liaised with the Police about anti-social behaviour, in particular off-road motorcycles and noise and nuisance neighbours, with some success.

I have reported pot-holes and street-lighting failures and ensured these faults have been rectified. Also I supported residents in their objections to an appeal to the Welsh Government Planning Inspectorate against an enforcement notice.

I have countersigned numerous passport applications and a shot-gun licence.

I have written a number of references for constituents applying for jobs.

I was Vice-Chair of Gelligaer Community Council in 2012-2013 and supported many funding applications from local voluntary organisations. I am the Community Council's delegate to One Voice Wales
