CONSTITUENCY ACTIVITY

I held weekly surgeries with Ward Colleagues and offer my constituents home appointments and they can also contact me by telephone, email and in person.

As Chair of local PACT meetings, I have worked with Police and Community Safety Officers to highlight the issues of concern in my ward and liaised with Local Ward Officers on numerous issues of concern to the ward.

I made representations and referrals on behalf of constituents with regard to highways issues, repairs, social housing issues and environmental concerns such as paving, overgrown hedgerows and dog fouling.
