

Vehicle Testing for Hackney Carriage & Private Hire Vehicles

A request has been received to the Licensing Authority to move away from the requirement for licensed hackney carriage and private hire vehicles to be tested at the council's testing station at Tir-y-Berth. As a licence holder we would seek your views in relation to future vehicle testing requirements

The Licensing Authority is intent upon maintaining MOT, plus additional elements of the taxi/private hire vehicle compliance check in order to ensure passenger safety and comfort. If the council were to consider an alternative provision for vehicle testing, these are the following options:

- a) Establish a number of 'approved' facilities that would be required to carry out the vehicle compliance check in addition to a standard MOT. This is likely to require a tender process by the Authority but would give a choice of a number of premises across the borough. The Authority would also carry out checks on the premises to ensure standardisation.
- b) Accept an MOT from any authorised MOT testing station which may then require the compliance test to be carried out separately at another location eg. Tir-y-Berth depot or CCBC offices.
