## **WARD ACTIVITY**

Over the past year I have continued carrying out my role as a Councillor, representing my community and providing assistance during a difficult time.

Represented several residents with housing issues.

Received many reports from residents regarding missed bin collections, food caddies and recycling issues.

Have reported and spoken with officers regarding the more complicated issues. I regularly took part in litter picks and path maintenance around the ward.

Alongside keep Wales tidy I arranged for a Litter picking Hub to be installed in Newbridge Leisure Centre so resident can borrow equipment to carry out their own litter picks.

Have successfully arranged for improved drainage under the Bridge St railway tunnel this has now been installed.

Working with resident to set up a safe to school route in Pentwynmawr, and to improve on current 1st traffic calming set up which causes issues.

Currently helping residents with an historical issue for over 20 years, who had been trying to find out who owns the land that their access road is on. I have established that the owner is an historic railways department and have arranged for maintenance to be carried out.

I have, with my ward Colleagues, arranged public meetings with regards to anti-social behaviour and we had in attendance representatives from Gwent Police, British Transport Police, Transport for Wales and Caerphilly Youth Services and local MP for Islwyn Chris Evans. These are still ongoing.
