Pengam

Facilitated meetings for traffic issues including moving traffic offences. Found advice and gave support needed with a social service issue, and interventions needed to combat speeding cars on the main road top of Pengam, fly tipping on the industrial estate, and advice on the social housing register.

Fair View Estate (including Fair View Hill, Fron Wen, Edw and Street, The Rise, Aneurin Avenue, Fairview bungalow and Floral Avenue).

Housing repairs (complaints, support and understanding the system) Cefn Forest and Fairview Estate Traffic issues (driving too fast, traffic volume and safe crossing, Parking issues, several accounts of fly-tipping including large items and abandoned cars, Litter, planning permission complaints and checks, misuse of premises, overgrowth of hedges, attempted to start residents' group. Land transfer, drainage issues, dampness, overgrowth and knotweed problems, bus shelter damage, advice about skips on highways, dangerous opening, yellow lines, accident with refuse lorry, land ownership. Support local groups with the renewal of a lease, monitor leisure centre use, support the wild garden project, support a local group to claim empowerment fund, potholes reporting, road safety and parking issues, repairs on extension, advice for scouts' group, advice on gatherings outside the home, advice on the registry office, Discussed defibrillators, reporting environmental health issues, vandalism, parking on pavements, delays in work, litter, collecting litter for voluntary litter picking groups, graffiti, Access gate.

Cefn Fforest

Assistance in understanding how to move when in unsuitable housing, fly-tipping, and reporting households with too many household refuge bins.

Britannia

Helped gain knowledge to assist residents without resources to access these services for themselves concerning grass-cutting and removal of items out of their gardens. Collect information on accessing nursing homes and care.
