Over the last 12 months I undertook the following constituency activity and achieved the following positive outcome for my ward

Attended Crumlin & Trinant Partnership meetings and a number of cleaning projects in Trinant & Crumlin were carried out. Attended Croespenmaen Residents & Tenants Association meetings. They were successful in obtaining a grant for a stonewall, & sign for Croespenmaen village. Working with a team to clean around the village, this work included the drainage work carried out Cherry Gove. I also attended a public meeting in Crumlin regarding solar farm project at Croespenmaen.

Crumlin successful in having repairs carried out on retaining wall Gladstone Street, Crumlin.

After a long battle with the Highways department, work was started on a drainage scheme at Cwm Nant y Gwynt Aberbeeg.
