SECTOR FUND AND THE WELSH CHURCH ACTS FUND

## 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To inform the Voluntary Sector Liaison Committee (VSLC) of the budget available for the Grants to the Voluntary Sector (GTVS) Fund for 2023/24 and the grants awarded between 1st November 2023 and 31st March 2024.
- 1.2 To inform the VSLC of the budget available for the GTVS Fund for 2024/25 and the grants awarded between 1st April and 31st May 2024.
- 1.3 To inform the VSLC of the budget available for the Welsh Church Acts Fund (WCAF) for 2023/24 and the grants awarded between 1st November 2023 and 31st March 2024.
- 1.4 To inform the VSLC of the budget available for the WCAF for 2024/25 and the grants awarded between 1st April and 31st May 2024.

## 2. SUMMARY

2.1 The report advises the VSLC of the grant allocations for both the Voluntary Sector budget and the Welsh Church Acts Fund budget for 2023/24 and 2024/25. It also provides details of applications received and approved by the Head of Financial Services and S151 Officer under delegated powers between 1st November 2023 and 31st March 2024 (2023/24 financial year) and 1st April and 31st May 2024 (2024/25 financial year), for each grant scheme.

## 3. RECOMMENDATIONS

3.1 That members of the VSLC note the applications received that meet the criteria for the GTVS Fund and the WCAF, which have already been approved by the Head of Financial Services and S151 Officer under delegated powers, and which are reported to the VSLC for information.

## 4. REASONS FOR THE RECOMMENDATIONS

4.1 To ensure that the applications received under this report are determined in accordance with the Council's scheme of delegation criteria.

# 5. THE REPORT

5.1 This is the latest update to the VSLC in relation to grants awarded under the GTVS Fund and the WCAF, following the disbanding of the Grants to the Voluntary Sector Panel.

# 5.2 GRANTS TO THE VOLUNTARY SECTOR BUDGET

5.2.1 The GTVS budget for 2023/24 is shown in the table below:

- 5.2.2 The GTVS budget for 2023-24 was £8,735. In addition, £106,351.67 was carried forward from underspends in previous years, resulting in a total available budget for 2023/24 of £115,086.67.
- 5.2.3 Between 1st November 2023 and 31st March 2024, 31 new General Criteria awards were made totalling £6,610 (a summary of the General Criteria categories for 2023/24 is included in Appendix 1 for information). These have been approved by the Head of Financial Services & S151 Officer under delegated powers and are reported to the VSLC for information only. The awards are summarised in the table below:

- 5.2.4 One application was received from the Kids Cancer Charity which was outside the General Criteria, and this application was considered at the Voluntary Sector Liaison Sub-committee on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023. A grant of £2,000 was recommended by the Sub-committee, and this amount was subsequently approved by the Head of Financial Services and S151 Officer under delegated powers.
- 5.2.5 After the awards detailed in the table above and paragraph 5.2.4 have been considered, the total value of the grant awards for 2023/24 was £27,210.
- 5.2.6 The GTVS budget for 2024/25 is shown in the table below:

- 5.2.7 The balance of the GTVS budget at the end of 2023/24 was £87,876.67. However, due to the financial position the Authority faces the amount carried forward to 2024/25 has been reduced to £31,525. The GTVS budget allocation for 2024/25 remains at £8,735. Therefore, the total available budget for 2024/25 is £40,260.
- 5.2.8 Members of the VSLC may be aware that when the review of the GTVS and WCAF budgets was concluded in 2022, Cabinet agreed to increase the GTVS General Criteria amounts each year in line with inflation. For 2024/25 this was an increase of 3.4%. This increase has been incorporated into the General Criteria grant values, and a summary of these is included at Appendix 2 for information.
- 5.2.9 Between 1<sup>st</sup> April and 31<sup>st</sup> May 2024, 58 new General Criteria awards were made totalling £15,735. These have been approved by the Head of Financial Services & S151 Officer under delegated powers and are reported to the VSLC for information only. The awards are summarised in the table overleaf.

5.2.10 It should be noted that the annual budget allocation for the GTVS is £8,735, and the grant allocations in the first two months of 2024/25 have exceeded this budget by £7,000. The carry forward amount of £31,525 will cover this overspend and fund applications for the remainder of the financial year, but once this is exhausted there will only be the annual amount available each year. Therefore, in future years it is likely that the value of applications received will exceed the budget available, and we will need to move to a situation where grants are allocated on a first come, first served basis.

## 5.3 WELSH CHURCH ACTS FUND

5.3.1 The total Welsh Church Acts Fund (WCAF) budget available for 2023/24 was £224,508.57. This consisted of the annual allocation from Monmouthshire County Council (£59,841.17) plus unallocated sums from previous years (£164,667.40).

- 5.3.3 One application was received from an individual in relation to the WCAF, and this application was considered at the Voluntary Sector Liaison Sub-committee on 30th November 2023. A grant of £1,500 was recommended by the Sub-committee, and this amount was subsequently approved by the Head of Financial Services & S151 Officer under delegated powers.
- 5.3.4 After the awards detailed in the table above and paragraph 5.3.3 have been considered, the total grant allocations for 2023/24 were £155,325.59.
- 5.3.5 The total Welsh Church Acts Fund (WCAF) budget available for 2024/25 is £127,219.70. This consists of the annual allocation from Monmouthshire County Council (£62,542.36) plus unallocated sums from previous years (£69,459.70).

5.3.7 Similar to the GTVS, the annual budget for the WCAF is in the region of £60k. In 2024/25 there is a carry forward amount of £69,459.70 in total. However, once this underspend is utilised only the annual budget will be available. Therefore, in future years it is likely that the value of applications received will exceed the budget available, and we will need to move to a situation where grants are allocated on a first come, first served basis. The Council may also consider reducing the maximum level of grant that can be applied for (the maximum level previously was £5,000).

#### 5.4 Conclusion

5.4.1 The report summarises all allocations made via the GTVS Fund and the WCAF between 1st November 2023 and 31st March 2024 (the 2023/24 financial year) and between 1st April and 31st May 2024 (the 2024/25 financial year). Further allocations will be reported to the VSLC at future meetings.

# 6. ASSUMPTIONS

There are no assumptions as the 2023/24 and the 2024/25 budgets have been confirmed, along with the carry forward amounts for each grant scheme.
