

Please find attached the overview of complaint data for Bryn Compost

Daily Data January 2015 - March 2015.

- All 3 months are now on the same chart. The number of calls received by NRW are in blue.
- If we have attended these reports there is a matching column on that date showing the odour detected (brown = farm, compost = yellow, no odour = green).
- Where the blue columns stand alone, this means we did not attend on that day.
- When we have carried out a Routine Inspection I have inserted this onto the graph for the corresponding day. The colour of the text here indicates if we detected an odour outside of the site boundary at this time using the same colour code as above
- I have also included some wind direction information in text above each day complaints were received. Where the wind direction = potential, this means there was a potential for the odours to be coming from the Bryn Compost facility & Gelliargwellt Uchaf Farm direction. Where wind = wrong direction, this indicates that the source of any odour could not have come from the Bryn Compost Facility or Gelliargwellt Uchaf Farm.

Two further graphs and map are included

- Odour Complaints for Bryn Compost March 2013 March 2015 (inc trend line)
- No. of complainants by Location 1st January to 31st March 2015 this is accompanied by a map showing the location of where the odours were detected. Postcodes were centralised and no specific addresses were used in the creation of this map.
